
# **Activity - Pairs**







To avoid confusion, give only one worksheet at a time to each student:










#### Complete plan of the supermarket







### Complete Map of Kellivale




#### Reading and understanding maps

Some students are unfamiliar with reading and understanding the concept of maps. The following activity turns the classroom into a map, and in this way, may help such students.

#### **Instructions**
